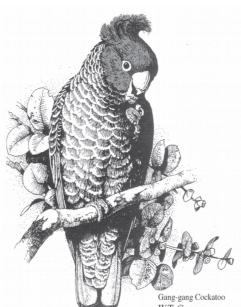

Instructions for the Garden Bird Survey

- Choose a survey area of about 3.1 hectares (equivalent to a circle of 100 metre radius) around or near your house or workplace or some other place of interest which you will survey regularly. Only include birds you observe within your survey area. There is no altitude limit, and there is no requirement for the birds to be "using" the area. Only record observations of species whose identification you are sure of. **If in doubt, leave it out.**
- Record observations in weeks. There is a column for each week. The start date for each week is at the top of each column. The survey year starts on 3 July and finishes with the week starting 26 June the following year. For each species observed (heard or seen), record the maximum number of individuals occurring in the site at any one time within that week. When you do not know the exact number, record your best conservative estimate.
- Write at most one number for each species per week (and, if applicable, a breeding code), no zeroes, dashes, ticks, or crosses. If you do not observe a species in a week, just leave the space blank. If you do no observing in a week, cross out the date at the top of the column but leave the rest of the column blank. There is a row for each species. 50 common species are listed and there is room for 18 other species. If you run out of room you can put additional species on a separate sheet of paper or ask for a second chart. For convenience you can write the day of the week that observations start in the box provided. Note that in leap years the day of the week changes from 5 March onward.
